

Terengganu Nature and Culture Day Trip



Shouldered by the Titiwangsa Mountain Range in the West, Terengganu landscape sprawls eastward to the South China Sea, with diverse and unique ecosystems in between. It is at the heart of the East Coast- the cradle of Malay culture- where much of the region's Nature and Culture has survived modern development, making it a refreshing change from the urban scenes and experiences in the West Coast.

This excursion provides the chance to discover a more subtle part of Terengganu, with visits to unique cultural locations around Kuala Terengganu as well as in state's unique coastal wetlands in Setiu, where participants will get a rare up-close introduction to the important relationship between local communities and the natural resources that they depend on for their livelihood.

PROGRAMME COST

The one-day programme costs RM250, which includes:

- Coach transportation (ex UMT) and boat ride

- Entrance Fees to Batik Workshop and Setiu Wetlands Broadwalk
